



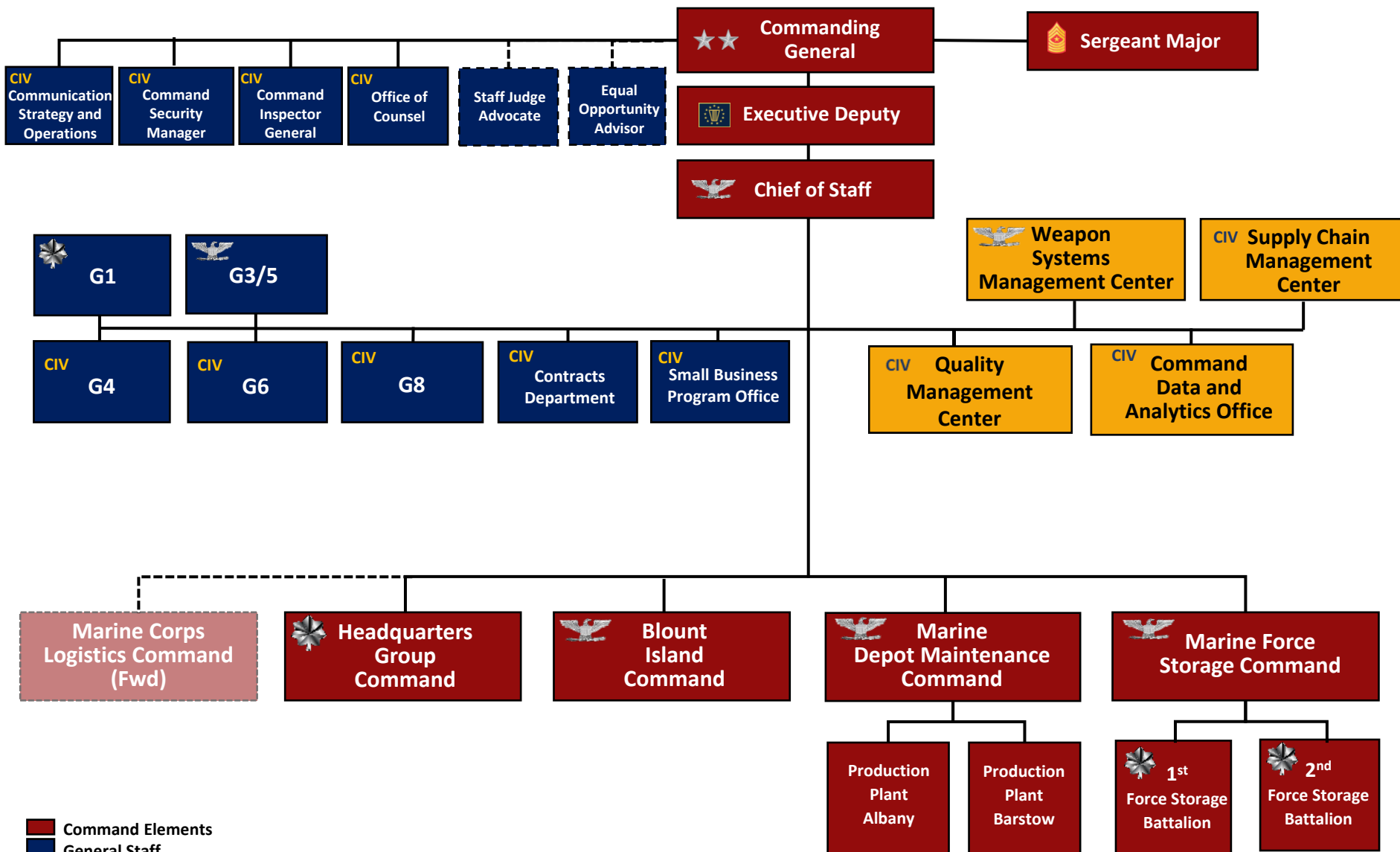

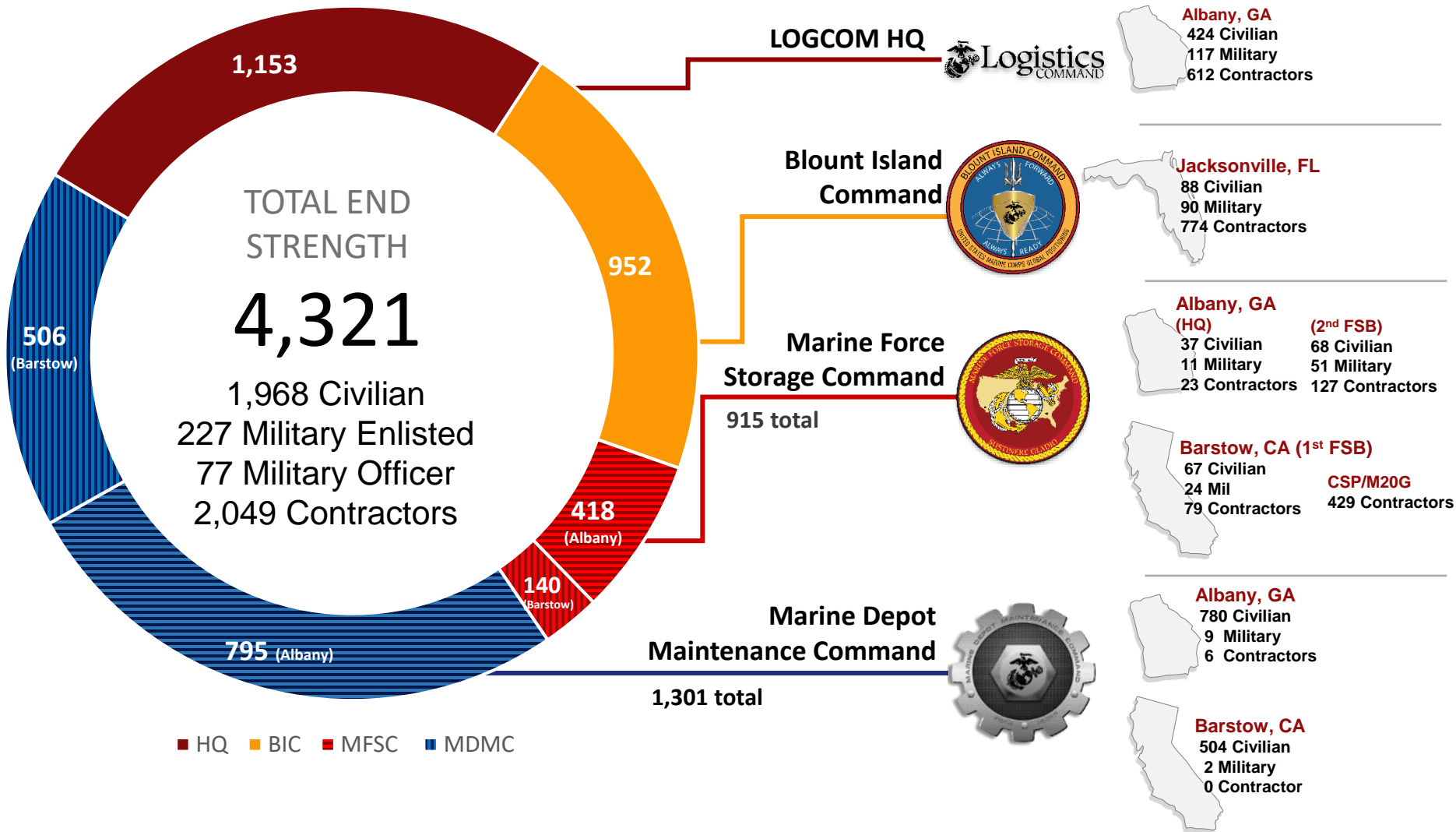

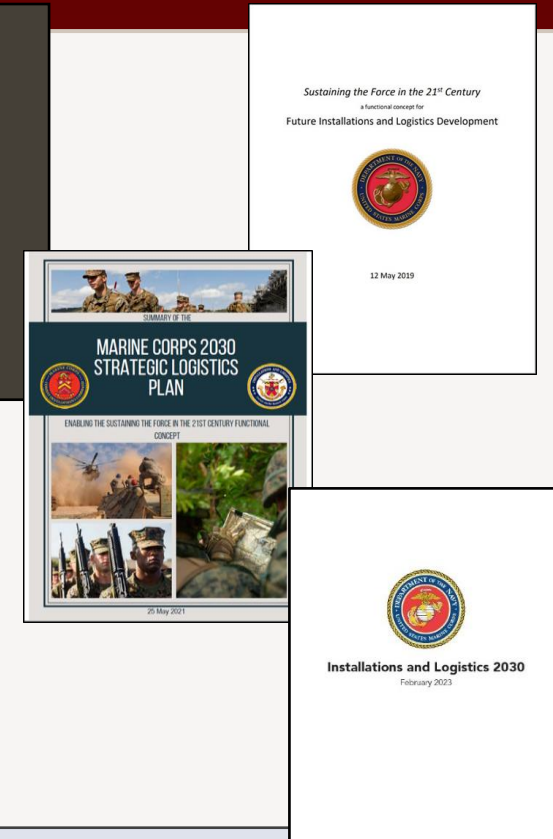

FY22 SMALL BUSINESS CONTRACT AWARDS

- » 34.09% (\$88M) Awarded to Small Business *(34%)
- » 22.1% (\$57M) Awarded to Small Disadvantaged Business *(13.5%)
- » 4.19% (\$10M) Awarded to Service Disable Veteran-owned *(1.7%)
- » 4.45% (\$11M) Awarded to Woman-owned Small Business *(3.1%)
- » 2.88% (\$7.4M) Awarded to HUBZone Small Business *(2.5%)

*(LOGCOM exceeded all Small Business goals)



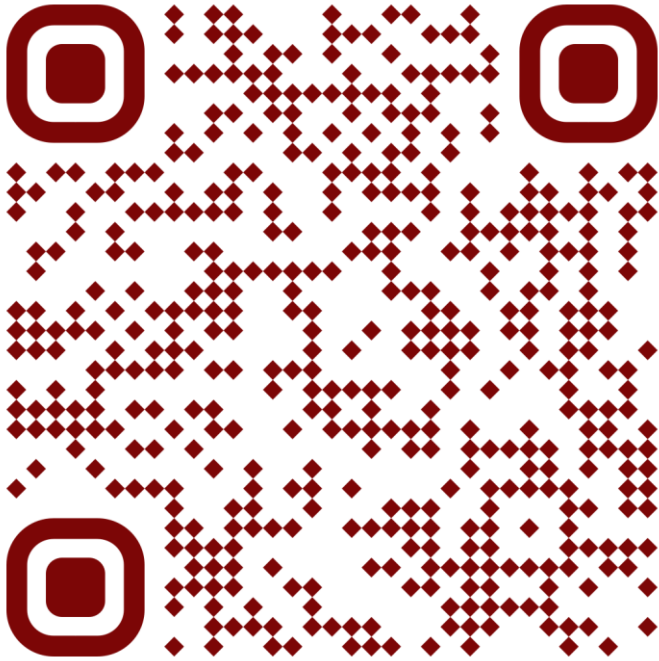

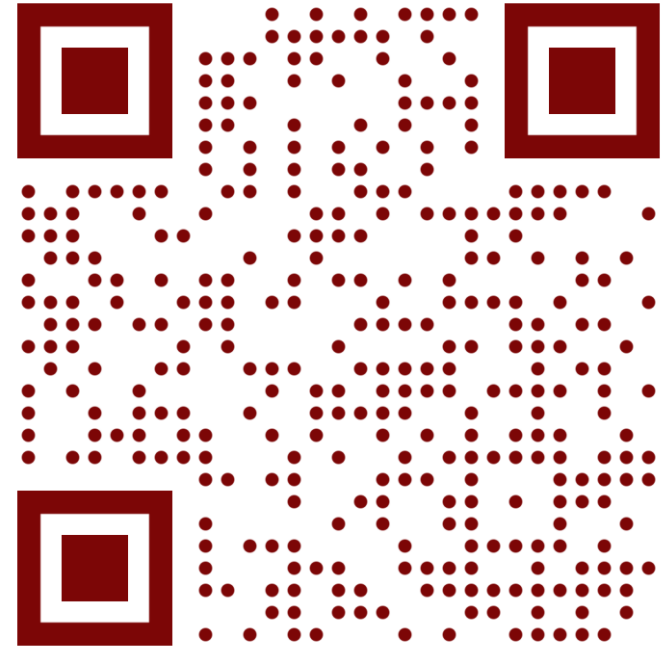
