

## Planned Safety Inspection of the LOGCOM Occupied Spaces

On 2 November, 2009, there was a planned safety inspection of the LOGCOM occupied spaces.

Due to an update in the approved use of surge protectors, many metal surge protectors were replaced with new approved non-metallic units by the LOGCOM safety office.

The microwave that was in the multi-purpose room (MPR) was removed due to filthy conditions and will not be returned. It was clearly a health hazard and since all employees use the MPR, responsibility for cleaning the unit could not be assigned and resulted in the unsightly and unhealthy condition.

Employees have been requested to keep and secure all medications at their workstations. NO medications are allowed in the general use refrigerators. Employees that utilize prescription medications that must be refrigerated should utilize a small waterproof cooler and ice/ice packs and secure the cooler at their workstation. NO small desktop/dormitory type refrigerators are authorized in B3700.

If you have water at your desk, like in a gallon jug, it must be labeled. If it's drinking water, label it as such. If water is used for a plant, the container needs to be labeled with "plant water."

No dishwashing liquid, air freshener or other type solvents are to be brought in from home. These items have to be purchased through DSSC where they have a visible NSN and bar code on the label.

No bug spray or pesticides in any form may be brought into the workspace. Rodent and pest control requests should be called in to the Emergency Trouble Desk ext. 639-5643.

Division Chiefs will do a walk thru of their areas on Monday, 16 November 2009 to check on all of the above.
