Celebrating Safety and Health in honor of our nation's Warfighters!

Please read and follow **all** of the rules carefully so that all posters will be eligible. The contest is open to all children related to LOGCOM Headquarters Marines and Civilian Marines. Posters that **BEST ILLUSTRATE AN APPLICABLE "SAFE SUMMER" THEME or SAFETY RELATING TO ANY OF THE 10 RECOGNIZED FEDERAL HOLIDAYS THEME** will be selected as winners. Winners will be chosen from each of the age groups. We urge you to think about safety and health scenarios such as outdoor play time, water sports, hunting, fishing, camping, fireworks, grilling, water safety to include personal craft and boating, and any other summer fun activity as well as the activities relative to the 10 recognized federal holidays. Posters should reflect safety and health hazards and include a narrative correction for the hazard or unsafe act.

ADDITIONAL CONTEST RULES

1. Entry is open to all children between the ages of 5 and 12 years. Entrants must be related to a LOGCOM Headquarters Marines and Civilian Marines.
2. Only one entry per child will be allowed. Age groups are 5 to 8 and 9 to 12 years.
3. **Entries must be received no later than COB July 7, 2016** in the IE&S office on the first floor of B3700, Room 138, Cube NW3.
4. Entries **must be** submitted on white paper **8.5" x 11"** in size. Posters larger or smaller than 8.5" x 11" will be disqualified.
5. On the back of each poster, contestants **must include** their full name, age, sponsor's name, floor number for B3700. This information must be submitted on the **bottom right corner on the back of the poster.**
6. Criteria for judging will include creativity and how well the poster expresses the contest theme.
7. Winners will be recognized at an awards ceremony on 25 July 2016 at 1530 in Bldg. 3700, first floor, the main lobby – right in front of the elevators.
8. Those who wish to keep their entries may pick them up at the IE&S office on the first floor of B3700, Room 138, Cube NW3 from July 27 thru August 10, 2016.
