

Analyze existing Supply Chain Integration processes and architecture, to include supporting business and management processes and provide recommended courses of actions on improvement.

Conduct in-depth analyses of supply chain performance resulting in sound recommendations for implementation; process and value stream mapping.

Develop recommendations for updates and/or modifications to LOGCOM and Marine Corps Logistics Supply Chain policies and Standard Operating Procedures.

Develop metrics and reporting capabilities in addition to trend analyses and prepare reports on the performance of LIS.

Develop and provide briefings, documents, and other communications relating to Supply Chain Integration for executive or senior management staff.

Organize and facilitate integrated product team (IPT) meetings to include the development of agenda items, the recording and tracking of action items and the generation of IPT status reports.

Provide technical analysis and subject matter expertise in the development of recommendations and guidance documents necessary to address National, DoD, and USMC Logistics Chain requirements such as improved production, distribution, reliability, training and, most importantly, better support of weapons systems and readiness requirements.

Analyze the impact of new DOD, Navy and Marine Corps policy Supply Integration

Develop metrics and metric reporting capabilities and prepare trend analyses and reports on the performance of supply chain performance.

Analyze and provide drafts of recommended policies, directives, instructions, campaign plans, implementation strategies, CONOPS, standards, benchmarks, analysis and briefings, in support of National, DoD, or USMC to ensure the survivability of both infrastructure and Logistics Chain goals and objectives.

Develop recommendations for the incorporation of survivability of the Logistics Chains in relevant Service planning.

Analyze concept definitions, technology maturation & transition, integration planning and programming, schedule development and analysis, risk management and analysis, decision support analysis, and the evaluation of the operational effectiveness and estimated costs of the alternative systems to meet a mission capability.

Provide a monthly and quarterly status report utilizing a government provided format.

Develop and provide trip reports for any conference meeting attended on direction from the government.
