References a. through c. establish the requirement for the management of distribution at the Department and Service levels. Reference d. appoints MCLC as the Distribution Process Owner (DPO) for the Marine Corps. In reference a., CG MARCORLOGCOM was directed to "develop a logistics chain team that includes supply, distribution, and materiel readiness components". As a result of the 2006 MARCORLOGCOM reorganization, the Distribution Management Center (DMC) was established as the lead for distribution. The Enterprise Distribution Department (EDD) within the DMC oversees the overall effectiveness, efficiency and alignment of USMC-wide distribution activities, including force projection, acquisition, sourcing, positioning, transportation processes, sustainment and redeployment/retrograde operations, to facilitate expeditious streamlined flow of equipment and materiel to the warfighter. Furthermore, in coordination with HQMC I&L, DMC establishes the concepts and operational framework relating to the planning and execution of USMC transportation operations, maintains liaison with the MARFORs, and develops and maintains USMC Distribution policy defining authority, accountability, resources and responsibility for distribution process management.

References e. and f. designate Service roles and responsibilities related to the Department of Defense Activity Address Directory (DoDAAD). The DoDAAD is the single authoritative data source of address information for DoD component application systems' data requirements. The address data is used by military services, federal agencies, and civil agencies for identification purposes and to requisition, ship, or receive materiel; fund/pay bills; and/or account for DoD-owned supplies and materiel. The Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DODAAC) is a six-position code that uniquely identifies a unit, activity, or organization. Management of the DoDAAD is a concerted effort on behalf of all agencies and components that are registered within the DoDAAD. Each service component of the DoD is required to maintain their portion of the DoDAAD accurate on an as-occurring basis and ensure compliance with standard DoDAAD procedures. This DoDAAD management requirement is the inherent responsibility of each Service component and its Central Service Point (CSP), Major Commands, and individual units. The DMC provides direct liaison with HQMC I&L LPC in performing CSP functions in support of distribution, financial, and supply systems throughout the Marine Corps.
