Consolidated Storage Program (CSP) ensures all Marines and Sailors have ready for issue and serviceable Class II equipment when and where required. CSP maintains a centralized item management and consolidated item storage operation to increasing USMC readiness and overall inventory asset visibility. The primary objective of the CSP is to provide both individual Marines and Marine Units with organizational issue; recovery; storage; requisitioning; maintenance; management (including visibility, accountability, automated inventory management, and forecasting) for the following families of items: Individual Combat Equipment (ICE); Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Defense (CBRND) equipment; Special Training Allowance Pool (STAP) (cold, hot, wet weather clothing and equipment, humanitarian effort assets, and any other designated specialty clothing and equipment item of current and future systems); Soft-Walled Shelters and cami-netting; other related Class II items (organizational equipment, i.e. special tool kits; fuel cans, and other designated mission essential equipment). CSP operates in an issue environment manned via 3PL contractors.
