Shelf Life Management is actions taken in order to minimize loss of product resulting from shelf life expiration prior to use. Actions include, but are not limited to monitoring of quantity/condition of shelf-life items; in filling requirements, issue of items with shortest remaining shelf-life; redistributions in order to use shelf-life items prior to expiration; requisitioning minimum quantities of shelf-life items; testing of shelf-life items in order to extend the shelf-life prior to expiration; determine disposition and take proper action on expired shelf-life items, etc. (Shelf-Life is the total period of time beginning with the date of manufacture, cure, assembly, or pack (subsistence only), that an item may remain in the combined wholesale (including manufacturer and retail storage systems, and still remain usable for issue and/or consumption by the end user).
