### FAQs

❖ **Where will DPAS initially get the data from?**

Mechanization of Warehousing and Shipment Processing (MoWASP), Stock Control System (STS), Set Assemble (ASA), and Weapons Serial File (WSF). Current distribution systems assets, serial numbers and condition codes will be migrated to DPAS.

❖ **If the serial numbers are wrong in the legacy system, will they be fixed?**

The serial numbers have to be physically verified then entered into DPAS to be fixed. The plan is to conduct a physical inventory and place tags on the assets with the correct serial numbers.

❖ **Will legacy systems be shut down or will they be archived?**

Information will stop being entered into the legacy systems. There is a big difference between shut down and archiving. The programs will be archived. Upon stop in processing, the daily schedule will be cancelled. Legacy systems of MoWASP will be shut down effective the date DPAS is turned on, meaning MoWASP on-line will no longer be used to eliminate duplicate input from two sources. Read access will be given to users for obtaining history from ASA, WSF, STS. If history is needed from MoWASP master history then a request can be made to generate a batch from NATURAL programs.

Additionally, all information is currently in the Master Data Repository (MDR) and in the future, DPAS will provide information directly to the MDR.
