Following his return, he was recognized for his critical contributions as SNCOIC in New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina, coordinating efforts that led to the evacuation of 650 individuals and over 300 mishap-free flight hours under challenging conditions. His military service has been recognized with awards including the Navy Unit Commendation, Army Achievement Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, and two Sea Service Deployment Ribbons.
