LIMITATIONS ON OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT AND ACTIVITIES

Federal Employees may not participate in any outside employment or other activity that conflicts with their official duties as an employee of the United States, including any employment, activity, or financial interest which might cause a reasonable person to question a Federal Employee's impartiality.

Federal Employees may not represent others before any court, agency, or other entity concerning matters of interest to the United States. This does not preclude acting as the unpaid representative of other Federal Employees facing disciplinary or other personnel actions or participation in legitimate union activities.

Federal Employees must not engage in outside activities or employment which violate the <u>14 General Principles of</u> <u>Ethical Conduct</u>, including the prohibition against engaging in activities that create the appearance of ethical impropriety.
