

# **MCLB Albany Directions**

For the most reliable driving directions to the main gate use the address 3010 Fleming Rd, Albany, GA 31705 in your GPS system.

- 1) From US-19 take exit 1 for GA-234 toward GA-133 S/Albany/Moultrie/Marine Corps Logistics Base
- 2) Turn left onto GA-234/Moultrie Rd (signs for MCLB/GA-133 S)
- 3) Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto S Mock Rd
- 4) Turn right onto Fleming Rd and travel 2.3 miles, the base main gate and visitor center will be on your left.

The most convenient method of getting to MCLB Albany is flying into Southwest Georgia Regional Airport. From there, it's only a ten-mile drive to base.

Johnson Rd. Gate - Monday-Sunday: 0530 - 1800


