The selectees for this position will serve as an Electrical Equipment Repairer Marine Depot Maintenance Command (MDMC), located Albany, GA. Perform general maintenance, installation, modification and overhaul on variety of military and commercial electrical devices and equipment, in support of the organization's operations.

#### **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT REPAIRER DUTIES:** (not all-inclusive)

- Performs diagnoses, modification, overhaul, repair and maintenance of complex electrical devices, equipment and components, including those which are integrated groupings of electrical and related controls containing printed and miniaturized electronic control circuitry.
- Independently services various complex electrical devices, equipment and components. Test, troubleshoots, disassembles, repairs, modifies, reassembles, and perform final checkout on such item's junction boxes, instrument panels, cable assemblies, light receptacles., rectifiers, generators/regulators, air cleaner blower motors. traverse motors, distribution boxes, traverse motor accessory control boxes, slip ring assemblies, gun firing selector switch assemblies, and power relay boxes.
- Prototypes and reviews new overhaul and rest procedures on items being introduced into the workload. Sets up and operates computer-controlled automatic test equipment (ATE) to run established and new diagnostic programs in various operational and functional test modes to perform pretest or final checkout or the electrical/electronic and interrelated systems.

- Basic Requirements:
  - Individual must possess a thorough knowledge of electrical theory and a knowledge of electronic theory to complete repairs on a variety of complex electrical systems and equipment containing diodes, transistors, and electronic devices in the circuitry. Ability to replace diodes, transistors, capacitors, resistors, and printed circuit boards.





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- Individual must have knowledge of mechanical theory and of pneumatic and hydraulic principles to isolate, repair, or replace faulty components such as hydraulic/pneumatic pressure regulators and hydraulic volume controls on many different types of equipment.
- Experience must show the ability to troubleshoot entire electrical systems and related equipment, determining cause of malfunction, and making required repairs.
- Individual must be able to interpret technical specifications, blueprints, schematics, and engineering drawings in planning and laying out, installing, modifying, and repairing electrical systems, circuits, equipment and controls.
- Individual must have the knowledge in using test equipment such as oscilloscopes, frequency meters, phrase rotation meters, and capacity and impedance bridges to troubleshoot, test, and repair equipment such as AC-DC convertors, AC-DC invertors, and power control panels.
- Individual must have the ability to set up and operate computer-controlled automated test equipment to run established and new diagnostic programs.
