The selectees for this position will serve as a Heavy Mobile Equipment Mechanic for Marine Depot Maintenance Command (MDMC), located Albany, GA. The purpose of this position is to perform journeyman level disassembly, self-inspection, repair, modification, assembly, and test all vehicular, utility, and special purpose equipment and related components processes within Product Teams.

HEAVY MOBILE EQUIPMENT MECHANIC DUTIES: (not all-inclusive)

- Disassembles equipment to a degree necessary to perform required repairs. Makes independent decisions consistent with repair process being utilized as to depth of disassembly with the extent of disassembly kept to minimum so that repairs can be accomplished at the least expense and still produce a completed unit that meets or exceeds the applicable performance and quality specifications. Extent of this disassembly may be completed disassembly or limited partial disassembly, according to the repair process standards being employed.
- Disassembles, inspects, repairs, rebuilds, modifies, tests, and adjusts wheeled and tracked combat vehicles such as trucks, cranes, rough terrain forklifts, scoop-leaders, scrapers, prime tankers, distillation, purification, and bath units, power generators, and fuel handling systems, wall rigs, both water and oil, retrievers, compressors, road graders, spreaders, ditch diggers, and bulldozers. Corrects rejects on engines, transmissions, and other component malfunction on tractors, cranes, tanks, loaders, and trucks. Makes repairs upon the vehicle, transmissions, transfers, and other related parts and components so specialized shops may correct troubles. Incumbent may be required to participate in the Product Acceptance Certification Program.
- Inspects and evaluates components and parts using exacting specifications such as technical manuals, process standards, drawings; blueprints, and precision measuring and gauging devices such as micrometers, pressure gauges, precision on clearance gauges, dial indicators, temperature gauges, spring testers, out of roundness gauges, depth gauges, vacuum gauges, and works to tolerances as close as .0001 inch. Determines extent of wear and acceptability for rouse and reclaims usable parts and components and discards those worn beyond acceptable wear limitations. Uses special tools such as torque wrenches, impact wrenches, drills (electric and pneumatic), special pullers (up to and including 100 ton), grinders, vices reamers, jacks, cranes, hoists, and wrench set (light and heavy duty), arbor presses, hydraulic presses (up to and including 150 ton), drill presses, power steering tester, and pallet lifts.

- Basic Requirements:
 - Individual must possess a comprehensive knowledge and high degree of skill in correcting malfunctions in wheeled and tracked combat vehicles, tractors, bulldozers, cranes, and other heavy mobile and special purpose equipment, and in diagnosing difficult performance problems. Evaluates, inspects, troubleshoots equipment being processed to determine the type, extent, and nature required to return equipment to serviceable condition. Effects required repairs to components installed in this equipment without requiring their removal, if possible. These vehicles incorporate complicated hydraulic, fuel, fore suppression, mechanical, electro-mechanical systems integrated into complex assemblies which control their operation and performance, such as interconnecting linkage between the engine and transmission of a crane that requires precise, critical adjustments for satisfactory performance of the vehicle.
 - Individual must be able to obtain a United States Government motor vehicle operator's license.
 - Individual must meet the physical requirements of the job.
 - Individual must possess the ability to utilize a wide variety of machinery, test and measuring devices, and specialized specification on a wide variety of combat, engineer, and special devising repair procedures where such procedures are not specifically stated. The incumbent is required to use seasoned judgment in determining the best work methods and work sequences to use in making extensive and complex repairs on this equipment.
 - Individual must have the knowledge, skill, and ability to manage workload commitments to prevent or alleviate production delays and scheduling conflicts.

Experience: Experience refers to paid and unpaid experience, including volunteer work done through National Service programs (e.g., Peace Corps, AmeriCorps) and other organizations (e.g., professional; philanthropic; religious; spiritual; community, student, social).
