PROGRAM ANALYST DUTIES: (not all-inclusive)

- The Primary purpose of this position is to provide managers with objectively based information for making decisions on the administrative and programmatic aspects of the production plant Operations and management, by accomplishing a wide variety of assignments concerned with effectiveness and efficiency of progress and operations.
- The employee studies the structure and/or functions of organizations with interrelated work processes or functions to resolve substantive issues, of moderate scope, and propose new organizational structures, realignment of functions, solution to space/supplies/equipment issues, and/or staffing levels to improve efficiency.
- Conducts management surveys and research projects and provides advisory services on substantive issues of moderate scope and impact to assess the effectiveness of program operations.
- Prepare detailed plans and perform work measurement methods and procedures, benchmarking, and/or studies for substantive work processes and functions that are interrelated to improve production efficiency.
